## **Tim Petrovic Carries Two-Shot Lead into Final Round at the Shaw Charity Classic Presented by Rogers**

**CALGARY**—Tim Petrovic remains at the top of the leaderboard, two shots clear of the field, after shooting a 66 on Saturday at the Shaw Charity Classic presented by Rogers.

Petrovic put himself in a great position heading into the final round at Canyon Meadows Golf and Country Club after backing up an opening-round 62 with a card that featured seven birdies and four bogeys.

“Obviously it wasn’t perfect. We always want that perfect round. Made a couple of sloppy bogeys that started with a couple bad drives, said Petrovic. “I bounced back after the bogeys and made a birdie just to keep the round going. I think that was important because you don’t want to make a bogey, make a bunch of pars, and then get another one.”

Petrovic will take the same mindset heading into the final round at the Shaw Charity Classic presented by Rogers.

“Have my game plan and one shot at a time. It sounds cliché, but that’s what you’ve got to do,” he added.

Petrovic leads the pack at 12-under followed by Ken Duke who made his 100th start on the PGA TOUR Champions this week. Duke posted a round of 64 to move into second at 10-under-par.

“The weather was absolutely perfect. It was good to get off to a good start and obviously finish well because all those holes are very difficult. Just had to hang in there.” said Duke after Saturday’s round.

“I played the Canadian Tour for seven years. It’s where I started my career. A family from Lacombe are here. A couple other friends are here, my pro-am guys came out. So, it's kind of like family. It's just a lot of good friends here, they welcome you in, which is great.”

Alan McLean leads the Canadians, sitting tied for 13th at 4-under-par. Mike Weir and Stephen Ames are both sitting at two under. David Morvland IV is tied for 60th.

The Tournament has raised more than \$93 million over 10 years that has been distributed amongst more than 270 youth-based charities in Alberta.
