

PRE-TOURNAMENT INTERVIEW: VIJAY SINGH

Q. So Vijay, you went out there and saw the course. What did you think?

VIJAY SINGH: Good golf course. Second time I've played it. Felt better today than it did on Tuesday. Every time you play a golf course for the second time it kind of opens up to you a little bit more. It looked a lot narrower the first day I played but today I was more comfortable.

Q. What about Calgary, what made you decide to come to Calgary?

VIJAY SINGH: It's a good tournament. Heard a lot about it from the players how the tournament is and a good golf course, everybody takes care of the players here, good crowds, so why not?

Q. How much was Carlos Franco working on you to --

VIJAY SINGH: Yeah, he was talking about it all year and I said okay, I'll think about it and think about it. Finally I said okay, I'll do it. So when I won with him in the Legends, I said okay, I'll come and play with you.

Q. Is he pretty persistent?

VIJAY SINGH: He was for a while, but he's a nice guy. I've known him forever.

Q. You still play events on the PGA TOUR, but how are you liking live on the PGA TOUR Champions?

VIJAY SINGH: Still getting used to it. It's a little laid back, three-day event. It's kind of getting used to starting on Fridays. You usually start a tournament on Thursday and then there's a cut, so you're really fired up Thursday. Here, you've got to be fired up Friday so it's a little different. Then as you play enough tournaments, you get used to it.
