



Q. Well, Nick, maybe just take us through this round today. 64, are you happy with it?

NICK FALDO: Yeah, are you kidding? I haven't shot 64 in whatever, a long time. It was nice to feel I could go for it, that was the goal for coming here and playing. I've been working on enough things that it's just putting it to test, so that was really great, a really nice day.

Q. You've had so little reps, can you ever feel close to something like that, do you get a sense of it?

NICK FALDO: No, you just have to -- I'm trying to put my trust in one swing. If I do something good, I've got to really remember it. It's not, like I say, I play really well for two months, these guys can say. I can say oh, I've hit a really good shot now, remember it, what did you do, can you do it again. So it was great. I learned from yesterday and fine tuned it a little bit, so I'm pretty chuffed for that.

Q. The front nine for you was particularly strong going minus four. Was there anything special about the front nine today?

NICK FALDO: Well, they were just good, solid shots. I hit a really good shot into 2 and holed that putt and somewhere else. Then 8 I hit a really good shot out of the rough, gave it a good rip out of there. No. 9 was a bit brave but bold down the right edge of the green and got away with that one. I hit it close, then hit those putts in, so that's what I've been grinding away on trying to find a form there.

Q. Can you describe this feeling? We don't know the number yet but to be right in contention at a tournament, can you describe that feeling?

NICK FALDO: I have no idea of that feeling, haven't been there for 20 years. Again, this is all new. Yeah, I'm just -- I've got my own little game plan and I'll see if I can stick to it tomorrow.

Q. It was pretty old hat for you for a long time. Does it put you at a disadvantage that you haven't been there for a while or can you dial it back again?

NICK FALDO: That will be a good trick if I can dial it back, yeah. That's what I'll try and do all the whatever, whatever you've got to dream up. But as I said, got a couple of those shots I'm working on and I'm fitting them in when I think it's right and go when I think it feels good. It felt good today.

Q. Just how much golf have you played this year, how many tournaments, and aside from that, have you --

NICK FALDO: I played three tournaments, so that's all this year. Actually four. I started the year in South Africa and I played one PGA TOUR Champions event, I played both the Senior Opens, American, Britain, and here. It's a limited schedule.

Q. And aside from that you don't play much, right?

NICK FALDO: No, I don't. I hit balls but I hardly play and I sit on my butt in the TV tower.

Q. Can you draw some inspiration from all the fans?

NICK FALDO: Yeah, the atmosphere is great here. Obviously it's good fun. People are chuffed that we're here so we're trying to entertain them.

Q. Were there any particular holes or moments that really stood out to you with the crowd?

NICK FALDO: Jeez, I love your questions. This one, this moment is a good one. You made my moment, M-12, you made my moment.
