Wasn't able to have a lot of good birdie opportunities and I had a lot of trying to save pars most of the day. To shoot the score I did today was actually not a bad effort considering where I put the ball.

Q. We talked earlier this week about what a top-10 machine you've been this year. Can you just add some perspective to what Scott's done to close out four this season?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: He's played fantastic. I played with him in the last group the last two times he's won and at Dick's he played amazingly good. Today he hit the ball good. He missed some short putts but he made some putts, too. So he's playing fantastic. He's got real good control of where the ball's going and he hits it a long ways and he's really tough right now.

Q. That control makes him a tough guy to reel in when he's up a couple?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Oh, yeah. He's going out there trying to make more birdies, so you know you have to make a few yourself. Miguel gave him a run, but Scott played really well today.

Q. Are you heading to Japan?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yes.

Q. What's that going to be like?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: I don't know. I'll let you know.

Q. It will be an interesting experience for you guys?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yeah. I've never been there, I'm looking forward to it. We'll see.
